
Programs and Resources Overview 2015

- MISSION: The Ohio Arts Council is a state agency that funds and supports quality arts experiences to strengthen Ohio communities culturally, educationally, and economically.
- VISION: Providing leadership and voice for the arts to transform people and communities.
- INVESTMENT and INNOVATION

- Founded in 1965
- Main offices in Rhodes State Office Tower, 30 East Broad St., 33rd floor
- Operates Riffe Gallery in Riffe Center for Government and the Arts
- Funded by Ohio Legislature and Ohio Governor
- OAC Board has 15 voting members, four non-voting

- Fiscal year 2015 budget of \$11.3 million
- Annual per capita, roughly \$0.98, ranking Ohio 17th
- Awarded \$9.9 million in grants to schools, artists, organizations presenting arts programming in FY 2014; overall request \$14.4 million (69 percent)
- Funded 632 applications in FY 2014; received 1,067 applications (59 percent)

- Competitive grant from NEA
- FY15 NEA grant \$949,700, all granted out
- 2nd highest grant in nation for the fifth year in a row
- Other funding received for Arts Education, Arts in Underserved Communities, Folk and Traditional Arts, Poetry Out Loud



"Eternal" is a full wall mural consisting of 45 panels of photographic Archival C-Prints face mounted to 3/16th inch UV Gallery Plexiglass, back and front. The artwork covers the whole lobby wall length of 90 ft, with a 1/2 inch margin on the left and right side. Each panel is 71 1/2 x 96 inches in dimension and is projecting two inches from the wall.
