

## PHOTOGRAPHY INTERNSHIP

Photographers will be responsible for taking and editing quality photographs of specified people, objects, and places and delivering materials within set deadlines. Intern will work independently and collaborate with others to complete tasks.

### POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INCLUDE

- Taking photographs at special events without causing disruption.
- Traveling on own or with staff to locations around Ohio to take photos of an area, building, person, or event.
- Collecting signatures for the commercial use and production of pictures that feature individuals when necessary.
- Coordinate and brainstorm with staff about which pictures need to be taken and their associative deadlines.
- Work closely with the staff to assist in producing photographs of professional quality within an established timeframe.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Pursuing a degree or minor in Photography, Art, Graphic Design, or a related area with emphasis on photo production and editing.
- Excellent focus and a good sense of priorities.
- Attention to detail and artistic ability with regard to photography.
- Ability to work independently 5-20 hours a week, and conduct themselves in a professional manner.
- Internet access and mobile phone.
- Working knowledge of various cameras and editing software including Adobe Photoshop.
- Applicants must provide samples of work.
- Reliable mode of transportation is highly recommended.
